#### Who Should Attend

This Cross Training program provides training for the "lay", non-lineworker personnel who may, at times be called into service to work alongside a qualified lineworker (after hours or in emergency for example). Regardless of the lay employee's role, it is crucial that they be sufficiently trained in the basics.

NOTE: All registration fees will increase \$50 on November 25, 2015.


Registration fee includes workshop tuition, materials, Wednesday lunch, refreshment breaks and a certificate of achievement.
