All apprentice events compete as individuals.

- Fall Restraint (required regardless of experience); MMUA has a limited number of fall restraint devices available.

  - Note Pad and Pen/Pencil

Optional: Rodeo Cart

**Note:** Fall restraint equipment is mandatory to compete in the Rodeo.

There is no registration fee for MMUA members to attend this event, however you must register for the event by February 24, 2017 (this ensures we have an accurate count for food, beverages, etc.).


