2023 Underground School Overview

Participants will be divided into groups and will rotate through the following six handson training sessions:

Troubleshooting secondary

This class is designed to give students an insight of megging secondary wire. Because secondary faults are a neverending issue, troubleshooting is of utmost importance. Instructors will cover different ways of restoring power. Participants will be taught the need for an add-a-phase and how to properly install one, as well as hooking up a meter socket with armored cable. After service has been restored, individuals work on finding the fault.

600-amp terminations

This session will help participants gain important knowledge in the process of terminating 500 MCM aluminum wire. Three different types of terminations will be taught. A skirted termination for a riser, 600-amp elbow in a PME switch, and a splice will all be covered. Proper tool selection and grounding will also be covered.



In this session, participants will gain hands-on experience operating a directional drill as well as the equipment needed to complete a project. Whether you have experience with a directional drill or not, this class will be beneficial.

Underground distribution design

Design of your underground distribution system is an extensive and complex capital venture. Understanding proper system layout & design, coupled with critical planning is essential to ensure system reliability, operability, and economic return on investment. We will review fundamental principles of proper underground design and other important topics.

Troubleshooting and fault-finding primary cable

In this session, students will be taught how to isolate and restore power on URD primary systems. Proper use of phasing sticks with DC hi-pot adapters, fault indicators and thumpers will be demonstrated to help students understand and address the issues related to URD faults.

Circuit isolation and switching

This session will cover the importance of following switching orders when they are needed to be completed. Instruction on proper steps will be taken to cover the techniques needed to switch and isolate underground equipment. Required procedures and use of tools and equipment will be taught on how to effectively test and ground your work area.
