About the Pre-Conference

Basic Metering

The Pre-Conference is designed to outline the basics of metering as a foundation for the Meter School Basic/Intermediate class.

The Pre-Conference will cover important topics such as:

- Definitions of common abbreviations
- Blondel's Theorem
- Common metering formulas
- Self-contained metering and troubleshooting



Meter School Overview

Meter School features two course options: Basic/Intermediate and Advanced. Each course offers a combination of classroom and hands-on exercises where participants will work at the metering stations with direct instructor oversight and feedback.

Basic/Intermediate Track

The Basic/Intermediate Class is aimed at personnel with little experience with electric meters. Instruction builds on the Pre-Conference, and will include hands-on training.

Basic/Intermediate Class will cover topics including:

- Why we have electric meters
- Single phase meters & meter forms
- Current transformers & voltage transformers
- Personal protective equipment
- Electric meter safety
- Tools needed for working with electric meters
- Mounting electric meter sockets
- Single phase socket wiring
- Troubleshooting electric installations
- Theft of electric power



Advanced Track

The Advanced Class is intended for those who have working knowledge of meters/metering. The course combines in-depth instruction with practical hands-on exercises that simulate scenarios that could occur at any utility.

Working in small groups, the Advanced Class will focus on troubleshooting a variety of challenging metering setups, then applying load to determine if correctly configured.
