

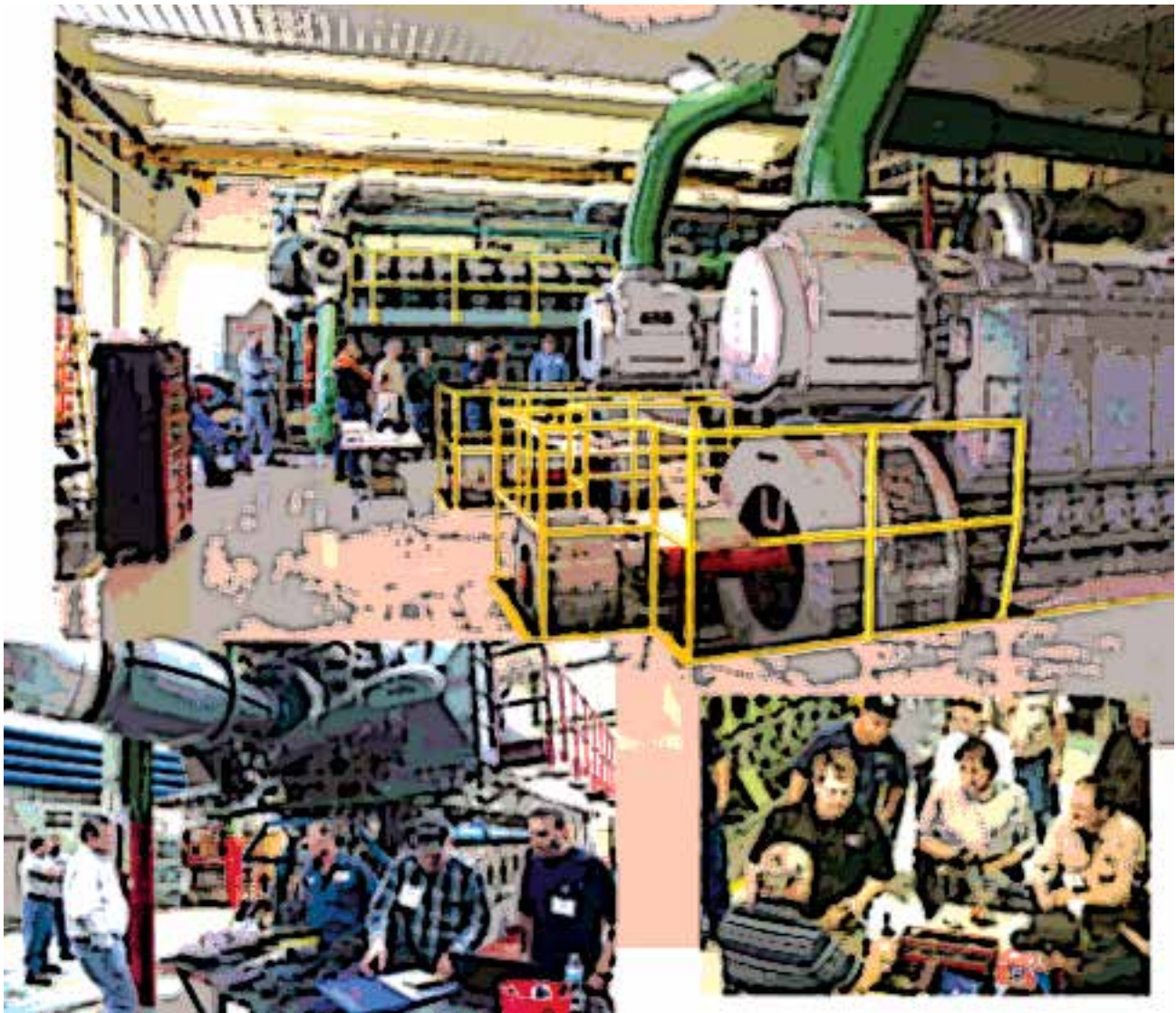


Minnesota Municipal Utilities Association
